God's exceeding work is directly related to the power at work (present) in us. What are the implications of such a habitation of His Spirit? The Spirit of God increases our capacity. Not only this, but He has decided to work through us according to what He's deposited within us.

Capacity is a culture of seekers. "You are free to roam about the Kingdom." This generation must pursue the Presence, promises, and gifts of God with tenacity and eagerness. A culture aware of His Presence. A balance of information and activation, worshiping from Wonder.

But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well. "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom.

You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
